
#### Svilengrad: On the Road to Zero Waste














First Zero Waste municipality in Bulgaria, innovator in environmental protection and waste management



Since 2018: official cooperation with environmental association Za Zemiata - Bulgarian member of Zero Waste Europe



#### Since June 2019 Svilengrad is on the Zero Waste Cities map



- **The Zero Waste Advisory Council:**
- includes active citizens, representatives of the business, non-governmental organizations, members of the local Parliament and municipal officials

Supports the Municipality of Svilengrad
Monitors the implementatino of a Zero Waste
Plan

First door-to-door separate collection of packaging in Bulgaria, including:
A pilot area of 1000 single-family houses
Shops and restaurants
The Municipality collects and transports the waste to its Eco center, where collected paper, plastic and metal are baled and sent for recycling



2017: Greenest municipaty prize in Ecopack Bulgaria competition with an innovative pilot project for separate collection of packaging from high-rise buildings



Three "Green eco zones" with electronic access for multi-family residential buildings



Mini "green eco zones" in all kindergartens Educational activities and games with kids at schools and during public events



- Separate collection of electrical and electronic equipment, batteries and other hazardous waste
- Separate collection used clothes and shoes from households, sorted and reused or recycled.
- The main purpose is to reduce the burning of textile waste and increasing the air quality.

### Next steps

Application for European funding for a demonstration project

Aiming to introduce PAYT (pay-as-youthrow) waste charge by weight using:

- on-board computer for data colleciton,
- ultrasonic sensors to measure waste bin capacity,
- software informatoin platform for smart waste collection,
- information and promotion campaign

A modern waste water tretment facility in operation since 3 years





A new composting facility for separately collected green and biodegradable waste Capacity: 3000 tons per year Funded by European structural and investment funds




Svilengrad has begun a difficult journey towards Zero Waste, striving to make its modest contribution in solving the global environmental problems caused by humankind
