Municipal waste and non-hazardous industrial waste disposed of in 11 landfills





Internalization of environmental and human health costs ensured by the provisions of the *Natural Resource Tax*Law

Tax Rates foreseen for:

- > Disposal of waste
- > Packaging and disposable tableware and accessories
- > Producers responsibility schemes
- Since 2008, Latvia has introduced higher tax rates for plastic bags attached by retailers to goods or products for customer's convenience or advertising design, regardless whether it is charged or not.



Law On Packaging

From 1 January 2019, the packer at the point of sale shall plastic carrier bags, including lightweight plastic, **shall no t be issued free of charge** to consumers, except for very lightweight plastic carrier bags,

➤inform consumers of the need for reducing the consumption of plastic carrier bags, of the alternative types of packaging available at the point of sale and of the possibility of using a bag or other packaging supplied;

With effect **from 1 January 2025**, the packer replaces light weight plastic carrier bags at the point of sale, with the exception of very lightweight plastic carrier bags, with packaging of paper and paperboard or other natural fibres and bioplastic materials
